Amen

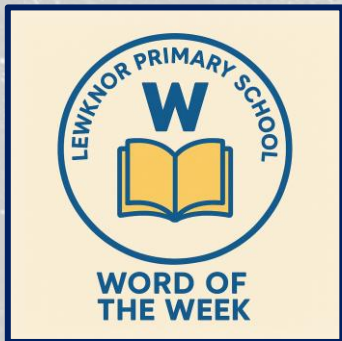
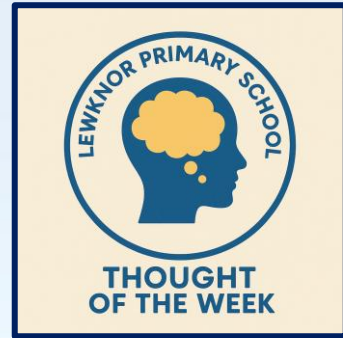
