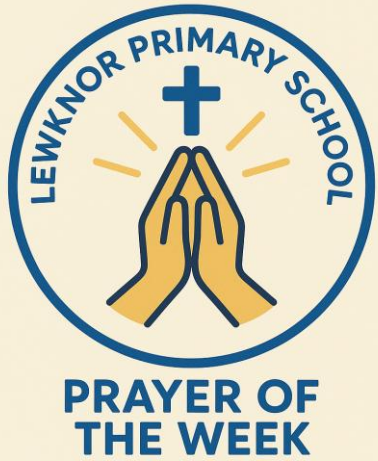

Amen.



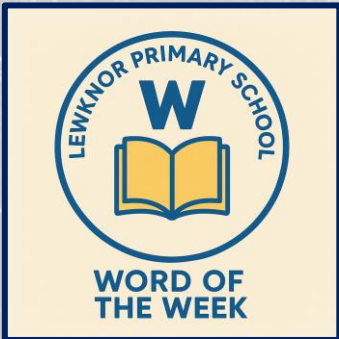
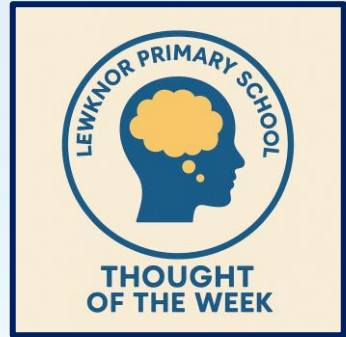
