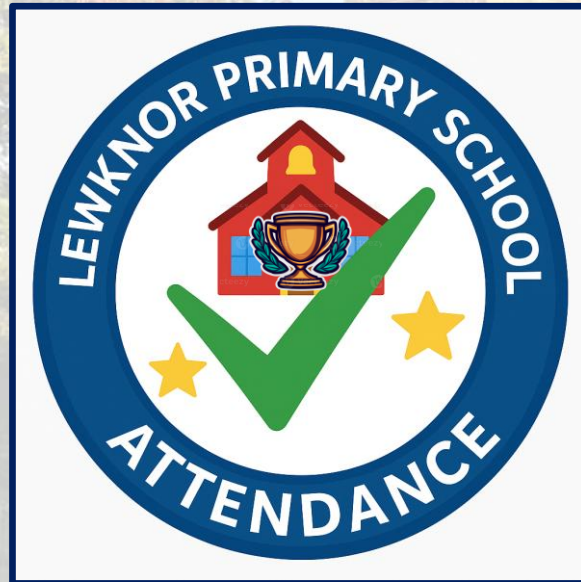

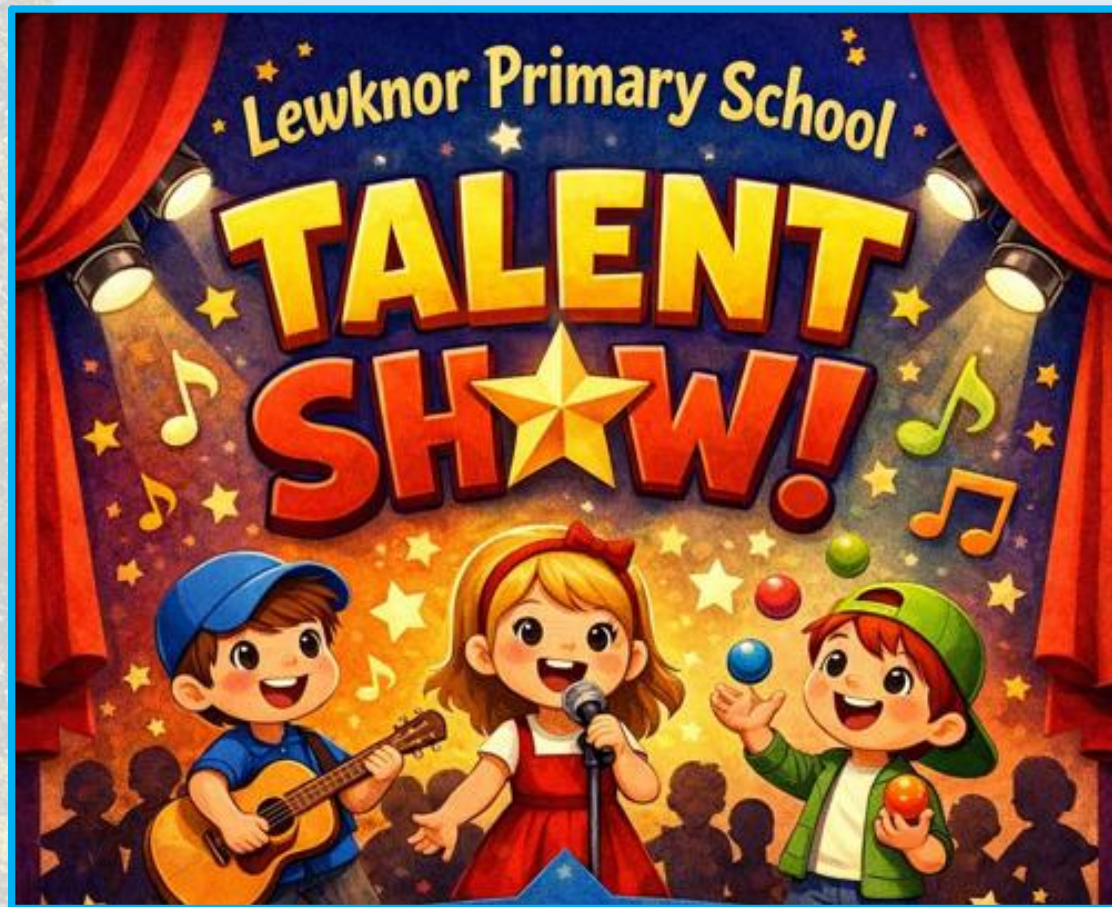

Amen.

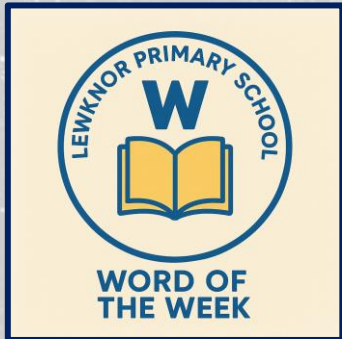
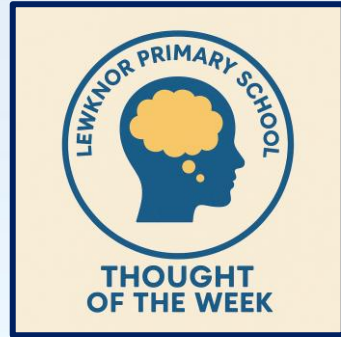
