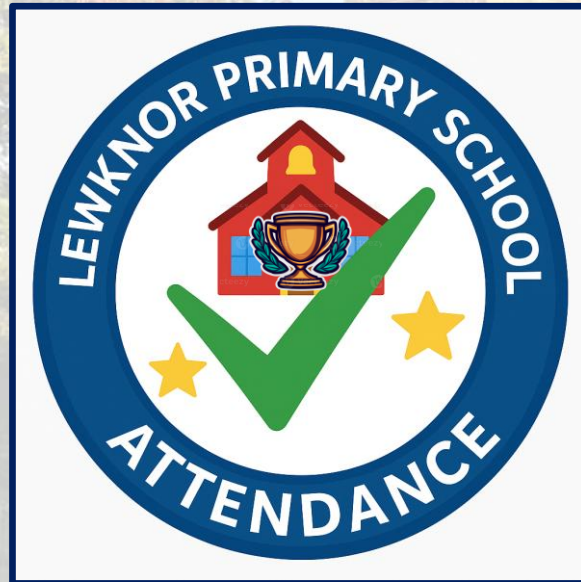

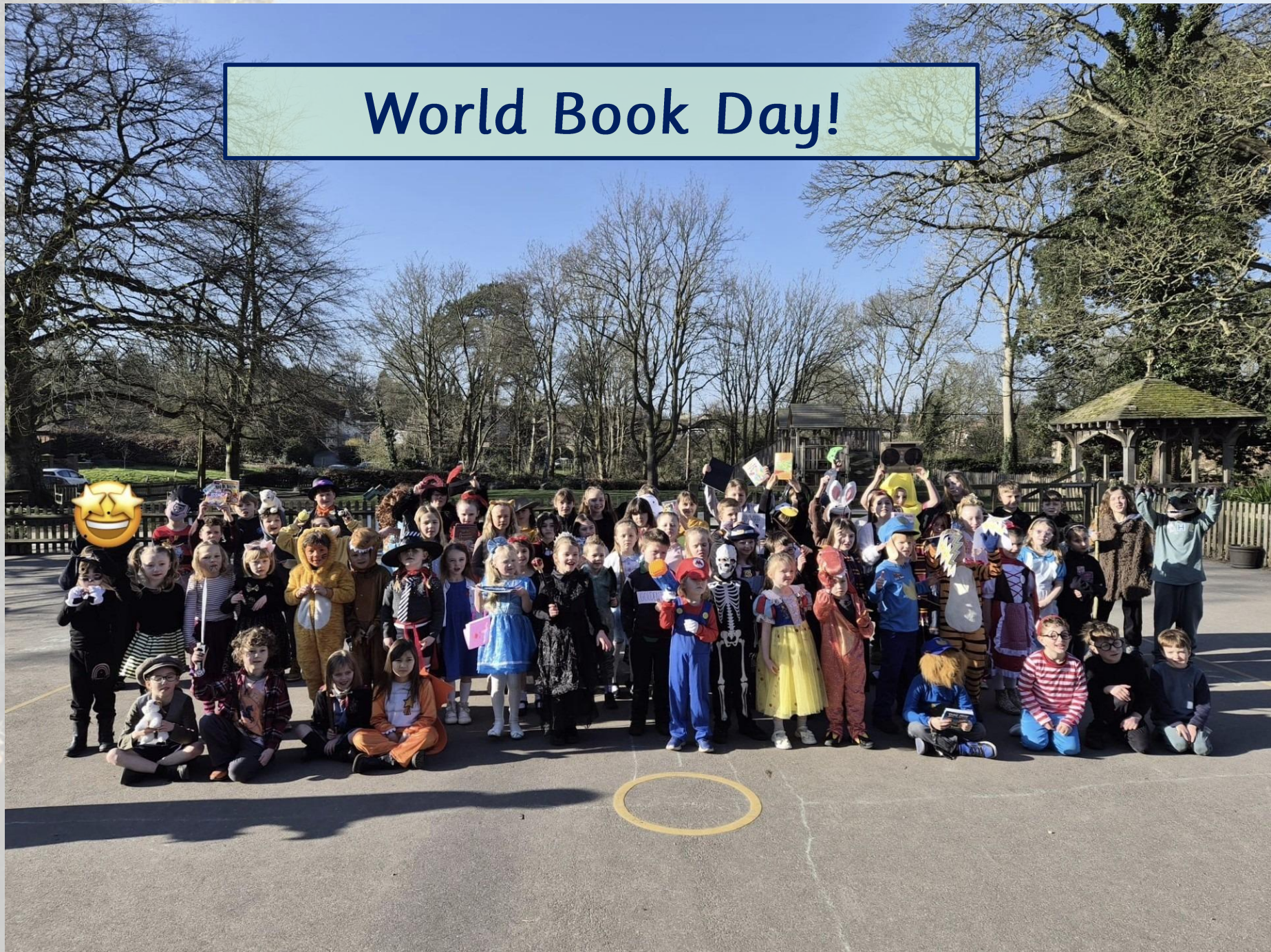

Amen.

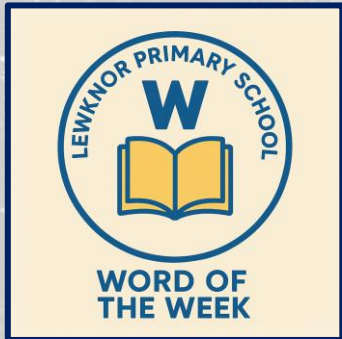
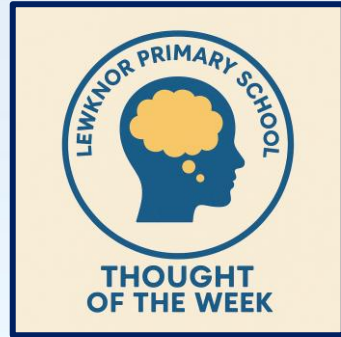
