Amen.

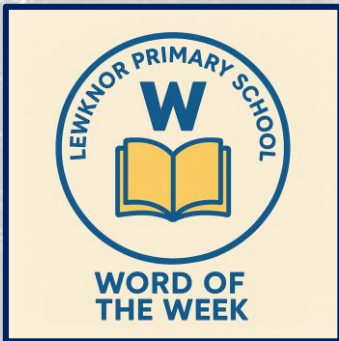
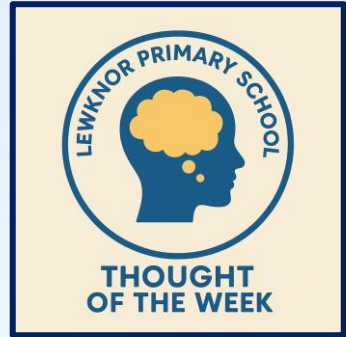

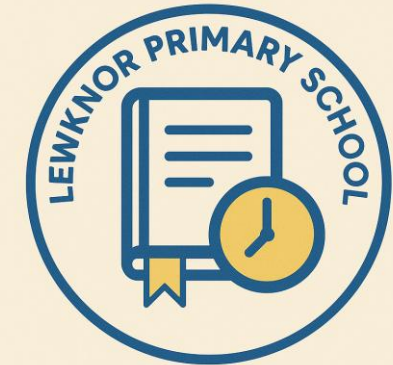
